**SURVEY ON FREE TRADE AGREEMENTS**

**I. INTRODUCTION**

1. With a view to providing accurate information to all Member administrations about free trade agreements (hereinafter referred to as "FTAs") and their importance vis-à-vis the Harmonized System, the Secretariat has conducted a "survey on free trade agreements" and reported on the issue to the HS Committee since its 27<sup>th</sup> Session.

**II. SECRETARIAT SURVEY**

2. Taking into consideration the comments made by some delegates at the 33<sup>rd</sup> Session, the Secretariat has updated the information provided in Doc. NC0807E1 as set out in Annexes I to III to this document. This year the survey put emphasis on revealing the share of imports from FTA countries. For the survey, the Secretariat has referred to WTO Web site concerning "Regional Trade Agreements Notified to the GATT/WTO and in force as of 4 January 2005". For the purposes of this survey, countries mean members of the FTAs, including territories. For convenience of analysis, shares of imports from FTA countries were computed based on trade statistics from the "Direction of Trade Statistics Yearbook" published by the International Monetary Fund. The survey was limited only to trade in goods.

3. Annex I to this document provides some information on FTAs such as the number of members of the FTAs, names of member countries, date of entry into force, types of agreements and information sources on each agreement. This survey takes account of the regional agreements which were notified to WTO as the type of Free Trade Agreement or Customs unions and in force. Non-reciprocal agreement and other agreements which are partial in scope and do not seek to become free trade areas or customs unions are excluded in this survey. As ten more countries became Member of EC as from 1 May 2004, the FTAs between these countries and the EC, on the one hand, and between these countries and non-EC countries, on the other, were excluded on the list. However, these countries are included in the Member of the EC for the survey concerning imports from FTA countries. Comparing previous year, the number of FTAs listed has decreased from 166 to 105.
4. Among the 105 FTAs listed, most (80 FTAs; 76%) were established among or with European countries including the EC, EFTA and/or CEFTA countries.
5. Annex II reveals trade information for all countries that had FTAs as of 31 December 2003. 44 % of the world's total imports (US\$ 7,745 billion) occurred among FTA member countries and 48 % of FTA member countries' total imports (US\$ 7,010 billion) came from other FTA member countries. In the case of European countries, 71 % of total imports (US\$ 2,425 billion) came from FTA member countries.
6. Annex III shows the distribution of country groups with different levels of the shares of imports from FTA member countries in terms of total import value in the year 2003. In the case of 26 countries, more than 70 % of the total import value came from the FTA member countries. For about 40 % (50 countries) of the 135 FTA member countries (as of 31 December 2003), over 50 % of total imports came from FTA member countries.

### III. SECRETARIAT COMMENTS

7. Given that 135 Countries (as of 4 January 2005) are involved in one or more FTAs and over 40 % of world trade takes place among FTA member countries, FTAs play an important role in world trade. In the future, more countries are expected to enter FTAs for various reasons. As the number of FTAs increases, the share of imports subject to free rates of duty will also increase.
8. This trend leads us to the following conclusions in respect of the Harmonized System as reported at the previous Sessions of the HS Committee:
  - Since FTAs eliminates Customs duties between members as against non-members, the Harmonized System is crucial for that purpose. Trade statistics based on the Harmonized System will also be essential to that end.
  - Since FTAs remove duties for goods originating in FTA member countries as against non-members, preferential rules of origin are essential and the Harmonized System is important to FTAs whose rule of origin is based on change in tariff classification.

### IV. CONCLUSION

9. The Committee is requested to take note of the results of the Secretariat's survey.
